

HEART OF AMERICA – CENTENNIAL CAMPOUT

September 24th – 26th, 2010

Location and Information

The Troop will be participating in the HOAC Centennial Campout to be held at the Centennial Campground at camp Naish. Troops will be provided with details regarding parking and transportation at a later date. All attendees will be required to park at designated locations and will be bussed into the campground. Scouts and Scouters should plan on leaving from the Church as a group on Friday evening, September 24th. We will return Sunday by the early afternoon. Additional details regarding the itinerary will be provided upon receipt from HOAC.

Only minimal equipment will be allowed to be carried in upon arrival. All meals will be provided so there will be no need to bring food, cooking gear, etc. Tents and other troop equipment will be delivered to the campground several days prior to the scheduled event.

HOAC will be employing security measures very similar to summer camp including requiring wristbands for all participants. Pre-registration is required and must be done no later than Sunday, August 15th, 2010 as indicated below. All Scouts and Scouters are encouraged to attend for the entire event. There is a specific procedure that must be followed for those that must arrive late or leave early. Contact Mr. Hartmann for additional details at least one week prior to the event.
